The Mediterranean Basin is a climate change "hot spot" – which means, by the end of this century:

- a rise in average temperatures of 3 to 5°C
- an expected decrease in precipitation of 35% on the southern and eastern shores and of 25% on the northern shore
 - a rise in sea level of 20 to 60 cm (IPCC forecasts, AR₅, 2013)

If you are implementing adaptation actions within the Mediterranean bioclimatic zone* in your capacity as a:

- local authority
- national agency
- public university
 - NGO in partnership with a local public stakeholder





Promote your actions by submitting an application in one of the three award categories:

- developments, infrastructure and buildings
 - ecosystems and natural resources
- methods for designing and implementing public policies

- international promotion of your actions
