## ENERGY BACKGROUND

THREE TIMES ENERGY NEEDED BY 2030 IN RESPONSE TO:



45 % demographic increase



90% of the final energy demand is covered by fossil fuels



3 times more cities of over 1 million inhabitants



Around 42 million dwellings needed



30 to 50% of all energy consumption is due to the residential sector



Need for nearly 200,000 eco-friendly jobs



EDENER is the Mediterranean Association of National Agencies for Energy Management. It brings together agencies in the Mediterranean region in charge of energy efficiency and the promotion of renewable energy sources, two key conditions for the success of the energy transition.

Created in Tunis in 1997 as an international non-profit organisation, today MEDENER brings together 12 national energy agencies from the Northern and Southern shores of the Mediterranean. The Presidency of MEDENER is held for a three-years period. Since October 2017, the Presidency is held by ENEA (Italy), following ANME (Tunisia) and ADEME (France).

In regard to future expansion, the organisation aims to include other countries and it is generally open to any national organisation that implements energy-related and environmental policies.

As key actor supporting energy transition in the Mediterranean region, MEDENER aims at:

- Facilitating the sharing of experiences, know-how and best practices among its members and international partners;

- Accelerating the transfer of skills, methods and technologies in the area of energy efficiency and renewable energy;
- Assisting countries in the Mediterranean region with the design and implementation of energy management policies.

MEDENER's activities entail the promotion of regional projects related to energy efficiency and renewable energy development, focusing particularly on:

- Increasing the skills of actors in the construction sector in the Mediterranean
- Setting up common standards for energy displays
- Managing a Mediterranean platform for monitoring energy efficiency indicators.

The association participates in the work carried out in the framework of the Union for Mediterranean (UfM).
